STANDARD OF DRESS

The aim of the OJA Standard of Dress is to maximize learning, minimize clothing cost, create school unity, and lessen social pressures.

APPEARANCE

Students will present a modest, clean, and neat appearance at all times. All clothing is to be properly sized, worn correctly, and appropriately for the weather and/or occasion. Tailored pants/shorts/skirts should be worn at the waist and closed-toe shoes are to be worn at all times. Clothing should be neat and in acceptable repair.

UNIFORM POLICY ADHERENCE

It is expected that all students will wear school uniform attire that meets the dress code from arrival at OJA until dismissal from the latest school activity. Parents are expected to support the school in ensuring adherence to the uniform policy prior to their student(s) arriving on campus. If a student is experiencing challenges meeting the uniform policy, school administration requests that parents/guardians contact the office for support.

If a student's attire does not adhere to the dress code, OJA staff will attempt to contact parents/guardians upon discovery. If the student cannot be brought into code within one hour, OJA will supply clothing and bill the student's account accordingly. Clothing items deemed not satisfactory for school will be retained at the reception desk.

NON-UNIFORM DAY ATTIRE

Certain days, such as Spirit Days or Designated Non-Uniform Days, will occasionally be designated and will be arranged by Administration. Advance notice will be given before these days occur.

Designated Non-Uniform Days – Students are permitted to wear non-uniform attire that is modest, appropriate, and follows the same general standards of the uniform policy. Students may not wear attire that promotes anything illegal, immoral, obscene, offensive, and/or a lifestyle that is not representative of Christ.

Spirit Days - A non-uniform day in which students may wear theme-based school spirit shirts or school polo with jeans/jean shorts/jean skirt and any closed-toe/heel shoes. Jeans with holes/rips or any form of disrepair are not acceptable. The same general standards as uniform policy are to be followed. For example, form-fitting or skin-tight pants or jeans (i.e. leggings/jeggings made from knit, jersey, or jean-like stretch material) are not permitted.

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

- Jewelry is not permitted in school for grades Pre-K - 8 or at any school-sponsored function--including off-campus events.
- Hair should be clean, maintained, and natural-looking so it doesn't negatively impact the learning environment.
- Make-up, if worn, should be natural looking.
- Nails should be clean and maintained. Nail polish is not permissible. Artificial nails may be worn by students in grade 8 for special events; however, for safety reasons, nails that end in points may not be worn at school or school functions.

SHIRT: Red short-sleeved polo with OJA Logo. Options Include:

- Short Sleeve Sport Polo (100% Polyester. Dri-fit/Dri-weave Option)
- Short Sleeve Interlock Polo with Picot Collar (60% Cotton/40% Polyester)
- Short Sleeve Pique Polo (60% Cotton/40% Polyester)
- Short Sleeve *Stretch* Pique Polo (97% Cotton/3% Elastane)

SHORTS / PANTS: Navy Blue (No cargo pants with additional external pockets)

SHOES: Closed-toe/heel shoes with a non-marking sole, any color. (Could be athletic shoes) No boots.

BELT: Solid color-Black or Brown; worn when pants/shorts have belt loops.

SOCKS: Solid color-Black, Brown, Navy Blue, White, or Red.

SKIRT / SKORT: Navy Blue.

TIGHTS / LEGGINGS: Solid color-Red, Navy Blue, or White, may be worn under skirt or skort.

SWEATER / LIGHT JACKET: OJA Logo. No writing, markings, or hoodies allowed.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM: *Required for grades 4th-8th.* Blue shirt with OJA emblem, red shorts, and athletic shoes.

SHIRT: Navy Blue short-sleeved polo with OJA Logo. Options Include:

- Short Sleeve Sport Polo (100% Polyester. Dri-fit/Dri-weave Option)
- Short Sleeve Interlock Polo with Picot Collar (60% Cotton/40% Polyester)
- Short Sleeve Pique Polo (60% Cotton/40% Polyester)
- Short Sleeve *Stretch* Pique Polo (97% Cotton/3% Elastane)

SHORTS / PANTS: Khaki (No cargo pants with additional external pockets)

SHOES: Closed-toe/heel shoes with non-marking sole, any color. (Could be athletic shoes) No boots.

BELT: Solid color-Black or Brown; worn when pants/shorts have belt loops.

SOCKS: Solid color-Black, Brown, Navy Blue, White, or Red

SKIRT / SKORT: Khaki

TIGHTS / LEGGINGS: Solid Red, Navy Blue, or White, may be worn under the skirt or skort.

SWEATER / LIGHT JACKET: OJA Logo. No writing, markings, or hoodies allowed.
